- Tanger Med is a port, logistics and industrial hub that became operational in 2007. Strategically located 15 kilometers from the Strait of Gibraltar, straddling the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean, Tanger Med connects to over 180 ports worldwide. This connectivity makes it the number one container port in the Mediterranean and the leading port in Africa.
- Beyond the port activity (a capacity of 9 million TEU containers), Tanger Med stands out for the following features:
 - Regional industrial competitiveness platform.
 - Tanger Med Services: an effective and innovative offering across multiple sectors (technology, industry, and water and electricity distribution).
 - The Tanger Med Foundation: a regional player in human development (education, health, vocational training as well as socio-cultural development).

Commercial operations at Container Terminal 3 (TC3) commenced in January 2021, providing Tangier Med with an additional capacity of 1.5 million containers.
