The future of relations between the Kingdom of Morocco and the Federal Republic of Germany

This conference, held on May 19, 2022, was attended by an important German delegation led by His Excellency Mr. Robert Dölger, Ambassador of Germany in Rabat, Moroccan diplomats as well as representatives of ministerial departments and Moroccan national agencies involved in Moroccan-German cooperation.

Exchanges focused on the prospects for the development of relations between Morocco and Germany, both bilaterally and in Europe, and on issues and areas of common interest, including Africa and the transatlantic area.

Day of reflection on the future of the region of Dakhla Oued -Eddahab

Bringing together many senior national and West African officials, as well as academic experts, this meeting, held on May 31, 2022, was an opportunity to address the development prospects of this region, the largest in Morocco in terms of area, as well as the pivotal role it is called to play in South-South cooperation, especially at the African level and in the articulation with the Atlantic and European spaces.

"Towards a new post-Covid-19 world: what prospects for Africa?"

On the occasion of the 27th edition of the International Book and Publishing Fair (SIEL), the Director General of IRES, Mr. Tawfik MOULINE led, on June 3, 2022, a conference on the theme "Towards a new post-Covid-19 world: what prospects for Africa?" attended by Moroccan and foreign personalities as well as academic experts.

10th edition of the Forum of Arab Thought and Culture

As an active member of the Coalition of Arab Research and Culture Centers, IRES organized, in Marrakech on June 8, 2022, the 10th edition of the Forum of Arab Thought and Culture, under the theme "The Arab world facing the new international challenges".

The final communiqué of this conference proposed a series of guidelines to strengthen the geopolitical positioning of the Arab world and its strategic sovereignty, in a context of increasing polarization and the rise of new areas of conflict, cyber, in particular, to improve the insertion of Arab economies in global value chains and promote the emergence of regional value chains to enable Arab countries to secure their access to strategic resources and achieve autonomy in the sectors of life. He also emphasized the need to reform governance and place the citizen at the heart of public policies and decision-making processes.

Setting a new trajectory for a new disruptive health model

On June 21, 2022, the Institute brought together a small circle of health science experts to present and discuss the main conclusions of the provisional summary report of the Foresight Day held on April 20, 2022, on the theme "What health system in Morocco in the light of national sovereignty and the generalization of social coverage?

At the end of this meeting, the debates highlighted the key issues of the future on which action should be focused and the levers of change that should be activated in order to implement a renovated, sovereign and inclusive Moroccan health model, in accordance with the High Royal Directions.

Reputation of Morocco in the world in 2022

IRES presented, on June 30, 2022, the main results of the eighth edition of the survey on the reputation of Morocco in the world, conducted by the Institute, as part of the work of its observatory on the image of Morocco internationally, in partnership with "Reputation Lab", an international firm specializing in the field of "Nation Branding.

The 2022 edition focused on the analysis of the reputation of the Kingdom in the G-7 countries + Russia and in 18 developed and / or emerging countries. It was characterized, compared to previous surveys, by the integration of new attributes, namely respect for human rights, environmental protection and efforts to combat climate change.

The methodology, adopted in 2022, allowed for a reorganization of the 22 attributes into five dimensions: Quality of life, Level of development, Institutional quality, Human factor, Ethics and responsibility.
